92 miles / approximate time: 2 hours

A state-designated Scenic Byway runs the 110 miles from Moravia to Donnellson. This portion of the Byway includes a winery, the American Gothic House in Eldon, the Amish Community of Drakesville, the Historic Bloomfield square, and some of lowa's most beautiful countryside.



- From Keosaugua, J-40 West to V-64 North, follow to Hwy. 16. Turn left (West) on Hwy. 16, follow to Eldon.
- In Eldon, follow signs to American Gothic House.
- At Casey's in Eldon, turn left to cross the river bridge and follow J-15 West to Floris.
- Follow J-15 to Hwy. 63, turn left (South).
- Follow Hwy. 63 to Co. Rd. J3T, turn right (West) to Drakesville.
- In Drakesville, V-17 South to Hwy. 2, turn left (East) on Hwy. 2 to Bloomfield.
- Turn left (North) on Hwy. 63 in Bloomfield.
- Turn right (East) on J-40 and follow into Keosaugua.



- MORMON TRAIL -

120 miles / approximate time: 3 hours

This route will take you along the mighty Mississippi River into history-rich Nauvoo, Illinois, the starting point of the famous Mormon migration to the West in 1846. You'll cross the longest, double-decker swing span bridge in the world as you make your way back up the scenic river road in Illinois to Fort Madison, lowa.



DIRECTIONS

- From Keosauqua, South on Hwy. 1, J-40 East to Bonaparte.
- Take W-40 South to Hwy, 2 East to Donnellson.
- At Donnellson, Hwy. 218 North to J-56 East, follow to Franklin.
- From Franklin, follow W-78 South to Hwy. 2 West. Turn left (South) on Hwy. 218.
- Follow Hwy. 218 South to J-62. Turn left (East) on J-62, follow to Hwy. 61.
- Turn right (South) on Hwy. 61 and follow to Mississippi River Road. Take Mississippi River Road into Montrose.
- In Montrose, follow Mississippi River Road, X-28 to Keokuk.
- In Keokuk, merge onto Grand Ave., turn right on 7th St., left at the light (Hwy. 136 East) to cross the river bridge into Illinois
- Follow Hwy. 96 North into Nauvoo.
- Continue on Hwy. 96 North to Niota, turn left to cross the double decker swing span bridge to Hwy. 61 into Ft. Madison.
- Turn left on Hwy. 61 / Ave. H to 18th St. / J-40 / Hwy. 103, turn right.
- Follow J-40 West into West Point.
- Continue on J-40. Turn right (North) on Hwy. 1.



Enjoy the journey through the historic and quaint Villages of Van Buren. You'll explore 1840's river villages as well as experience some Old World cultural in our Amish and

Mennonite communities.

- From Keosauqua, Hwy. 1 South to J-40 East to Bentonsport.
- Follow J-40 East to Bonaparte.
- Turn left (South) on W-40 to Hwy. 2 East.
- Follow Hwy 2 East to Farmington.
- Turn right on S. 3rd St. and follow to Hel-Mart.
- Turn left on State St. to Hwy. 2. Turn left (West) follow to 4-way stop. Turn right at 4-way stop and follow W-46 North to J-40. Turn left (West) on J-40 to W-40.

- Turn right (North) on W-40 and follow to Hwy. 16.
- Take Hwy. 16 West to W-30, turn right (North) to Stockport.
- Turn left (West) at 4-way, follow J-16 to Birmingham. Take Hwy. 1 South to Hwy. 16 West to Douds.

- Turn left (South) on Hwy. 98, which turns to V-64. Follow V-64 to Lebanon. Turn right (West) at 4-way stop.
- Continue on J-40 West to V-56 South, follow to Milton.
- Follow Hwy. 2 East to Cantril.
- Continue on Hwy. 2 East to W-20.
- Turn right (South) on W-20 to Mt. Sterling.
- Take W-20 back to Hwy. 2 West.
- Hwy. 2 West to Hwy. 1 North and follow to Keosauqua.


STATE LINE RALLY ASSOCIATION
